



Group: Sign in on Group-Work Sheet

Recorder: Person with most vowels in first name (Recorders listen as well as contribute to group discussions and complete any writing tasks assigned)

Reporter: Person with fewest vowels in first name (Reporters listen as well as contribute to group discussions and are prepared to report the group's work.)

Moderator: That leaves you (Moderators listen as well as contribute to group discussions and are also responsible for turning in any group work)

These are your first impressions, so you cannot be wrong as long as you provide evidence from what you see to support your conclusions.

You might consider, for instance, what building materials were used? Why do you think these materials were chosen? How long do you think the building was meant to last? What do you think the purpose of the building was? What do you think the designers meant those living here to feel about themselves? About their futures? (Be sure to use specific descriptions of the building to provide evidence for your conclusions).
